



How Fore Tour Works

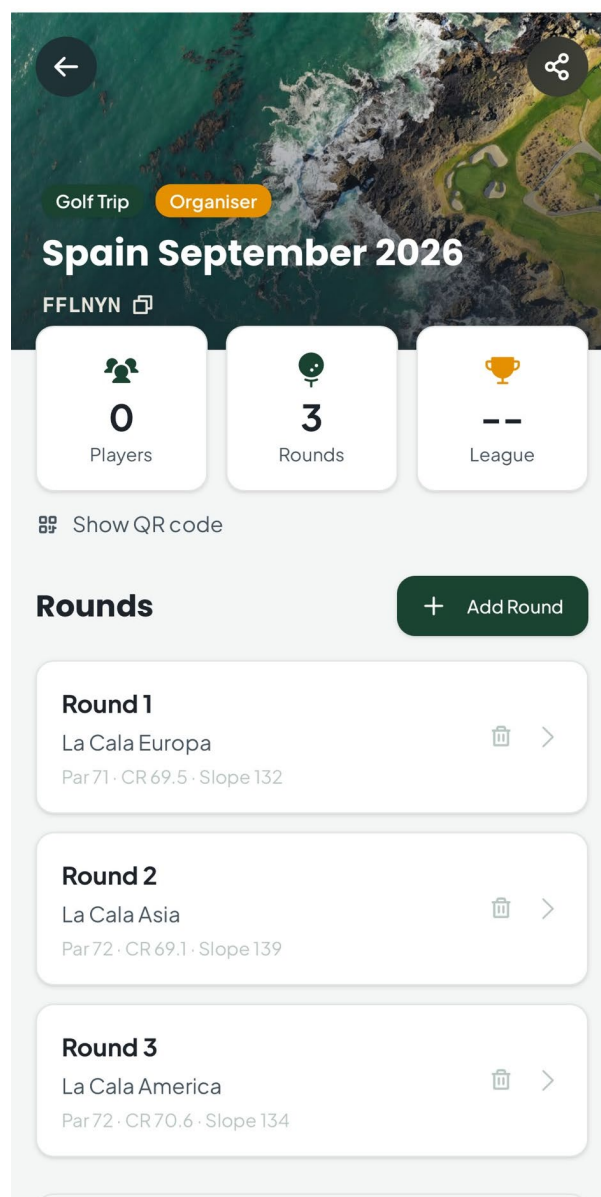
A simple guide for organisers and players — from setting up your first trip to reading the final leaderboard.

For Organisers

1. Set up your trip

Answer two questions — how many rounds, how many players — and Fore Tour builds your trip from there. Add your players with their name and WHS handicap index, and add each round with its course, tees, and start time. You can add players or rounds at any point from the trip dashboard, if you go over your plan's allowance, Fore Tour will let you add extra capacity.

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Your trip dashboard — rounds, players, and league table all in one place.

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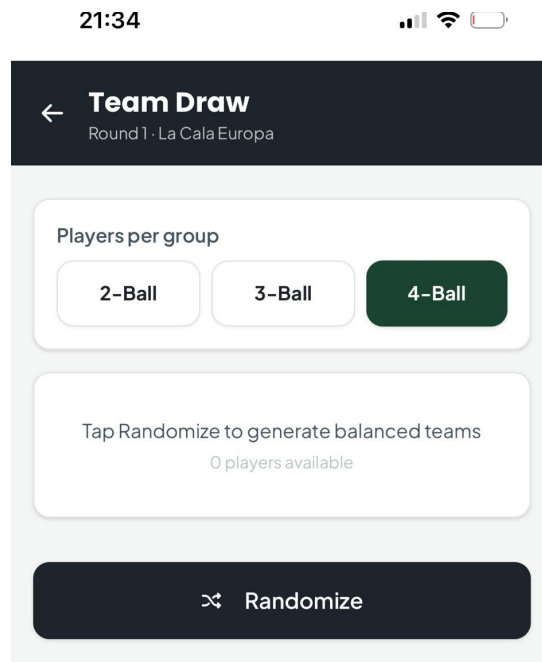


2. Choose your format

Every round can run as **Stableford** (points-based, forgiving of a bad hole) or **Net Stroke Play** (gross score minus handicap, lowest wins). Mix formats across a multi-round trip if you like, a Stableford opener, a stroke-play final.

3. Draw your teams

If you're running team competition, Fore Tour handles the draw for you, randomised, handicap-balanced groups of 2, 3, or 4. Or switch team scoring off entirely and keep it individual.

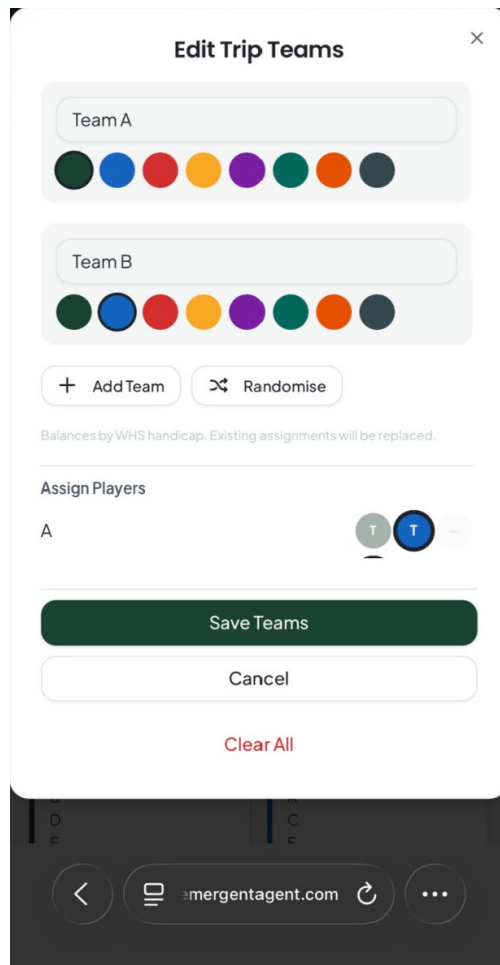


Choose your group size and let Fore Tour randomise balanced teams.



4. Set up Trip Teams (optional)

This is different from the groups above — those decide who plays together on the course each round. Trip Teams decide which side each player is on for the whole trip, for example Greens vs Blues across every round. Add two or more teams, then tap a player's bubble to assign them. Tap Randomise to split everyone into balanced teams by WHS handicap — this replaces any existing assignments, so it's best used before you've hand-picked anyone. Team totals appear on their own tab on the league table, with each player's individual contribution shown alongside the team score, and frozen rounds are respected there too.



Assign players to fixed teams for the whole trip, or tap Randomise for a handicap-balanced split.



5. Set your tee times

Choose a start type — Standard (Sequential) for a normal staggered tee sheet, or Shotgun for everyone starting on different holes at once — then set the first tee time and the gap between groups. Players see their own tee time in the app, so there's no separate sheet to print or share.

Set your start type, first tee time, and gap between groups — players see it in the app.

6. Start scoring — and lock it in

Once everything's set, tap **Start Scoring** to open the round up to players.

Important: once you tap Start Scoring, the round's setup — course, tees, format, and team draw — locks in and can't be changed. Double-check everything before you start.

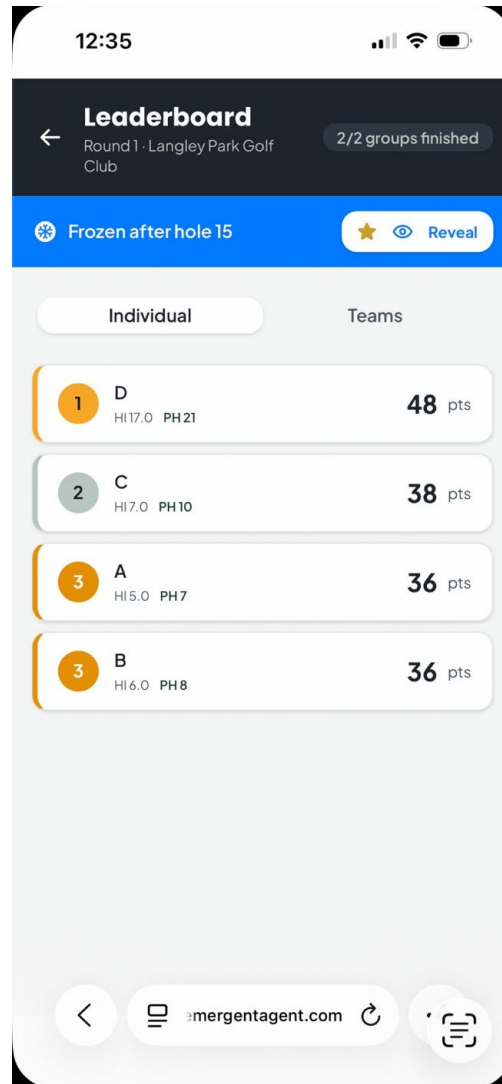
7. Share the join code

Every trip gets its own code, players just enter it to join, no account or download needed. A QR code is also available if you'd rather, they scan than type.



8. Build suspense with a frozen leaderboard

Set a hole after which the leaderboard hides live standings until you choose to reveal it, perfect for a dramatic finish on the last few holes of a competition. When you're ready, tap Reveal to unfreeze the standings for everyone at once.



Frozen after hole 15 – tap Reveal when you're ready to show the room.



9. Rotate the Scoring PIN

Every trip has a Scoring PIN, shown on the trip dashboard, that players enter alongside the join code to access scoring. If you ever need to shut off access — a PIN shared more widely than intended, for example — tap Rotate to generate a new one instantly. Anyone still on the old PIN is signed out immediately and asked to re-enter the new one to carry on scoring. The new PIN is shown to you to pass on; it isn't emailed anywhere, so make sure you have a way to share it with your players before you rotate.

For Players

1. Join with the code

Enter the code your organiser sent you. No sign-up, no app download, it works straight in your phone's browser.

Tip: clearing your phone's browser history can remove the trip from your recent list — you can always get back in by re-entering the join code. To avoid this altogether, add Fore Tour to your home screen (Share → Add to Home Screen on iPhone), which also makes it easy to pick up new updates as they're released.

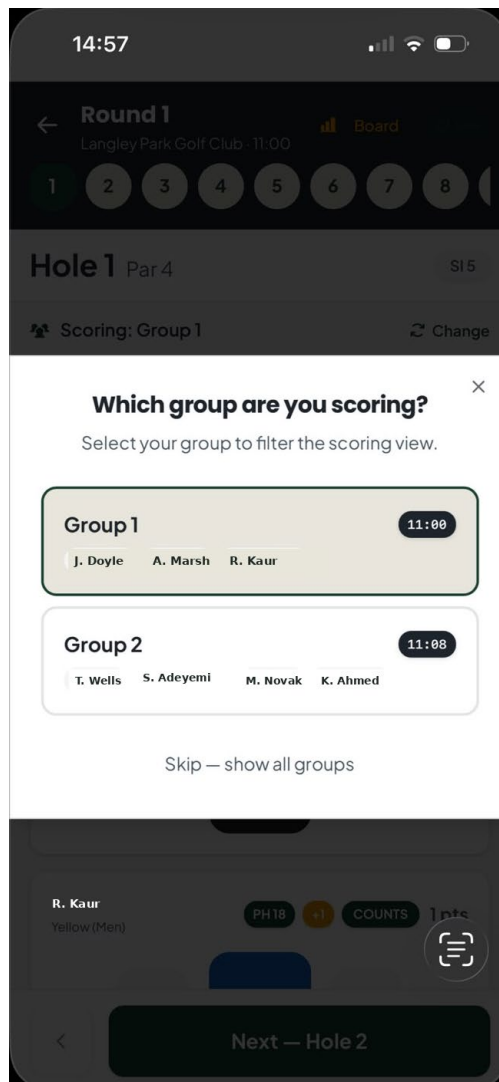
2. Score for your group

One person per group scores for everyone, hole by hole, tap in the strokes as you play. Everyone else in the group can follow along live.

Tap + or – to adjust a score or tap the number itself to type it directly. Made a mistake on an earlier hole? Tap any hole number at the top of the screen to jump back and fix it.

You don't need to keep the app open between holes, and there's no need for paper scorecards as a backup, everything's saved as you go.

If more than one group is playing, you'll be asked which group you're scoring for when you open the round — pick it once and the scoring screen filters to just your players.



Pick your group once, and the scoring view filters to just your players.

Scoring a hole – tap the number to type a score, or use + and – to adjust it.

3. Finish the round

Once you've entered the 18th hole, tap Finish Round. This locks your group's scores in for good – so it's worth a last check before you tap it.



4. Watch the leaderboard

See how you're doing against the rest of the field as you play, or, if your organiser has frozen it, wait for the big reveal at the end.

The league table — live standings, or a frozen reveal on the final holes.

If your organiser has set up Trip Teams, you'll also see a Trip Teams tab on the league table showing your team's combined score alongside a Groups tab for your round-by-round pairing.

5. Check the full scorecard

Every round's full 18-hole card is there afterwards, front nine, back nine, and your total.

For Multi-Round Trips & Societies

Running more than one round? Fore Tour keeps a season-long league table across every round in your trip, split by format so a Stableford leader and a stroke-play leader are never mixed into one meaningless number.

For the last round of a trip, toggle Final Round on in that round's settings. Once every prior round in the same format has been revealed, Fore Tour automatically seeds the draw from the cumulative standings — the leading players are grouped together and placed in the last tee time, so the trip's outcome is still live when the leaders go out. Group sizes match whatever you used in earlier rounds, so a trip run as 2-balls stays 2-balls for the final. Until the standings are ready, you'll see a "Waiting for prior rounds to be revealed" message instead of a draw.
