1. Who we are

Fore Tour ("Fore Tour", "we", "us", "our") operates the website at foretour.co.uk and the application at app.foretour.co.uk.

2. What this policy covers

This policy covers:

- Visitors to foretour.co.uk, including anyone who submits the "Get Started" enquiry form
- Organisers and players who use the Fore Tour app to set up trips, join rounds, and enter scores

Fore Tour is currently in active testing with a small number of real users. Some data handling described below may change as the product develops – this policy will be updated to reflect that.

3. What personal data we collect

From the website

- Name, email address, golf club or society name, rough trip size, and any message you provide via the "Get Started" form

From the app

- Player names
- Player-entered WHS handicap index
- Golf club / society and course information entered when setting up a trip or round
- Scores entered during a round, and resulting leaderboard/league data

Fore Tour does not integrate with an official handicap database (WHS, England Golf, or similar). The handicap index shown in the app is entered directly by the player and is not independently verified.

Collected automatically

- Standard technical data such as IP address and browser type, collected automatically by our hosting providers as part of normal web server operation

When you pay

When you pay via a payment link, our payment provider (Revolut) processes your payment details directly – we do not receive or store your full card details. We may receive limited payment-related information from Revolut, such as confirmation a payment has been made, the amount, and the name or email used to pay, so we can keep your booking up to date.

4. Why we use your data

- To respond to enquiries and set up a trip you've asked about

- To operate the scoring, leaderboard, and league features you use in the app
- To fix bugs and improve the product based on real usage during testing

We do not use your data for marketing communications without asking you first.

5. Who we share data with

We use a small number of third-party services to run Fore Tour. They process data on our behalf, only as needed to provide the service, we do not sell personal data to anyone.

- Formspree – processes submissions from the website's contact and "Get Started" forms
- MongoDB Atlas – hosts the app's database
- Emergent – hosts and runs the application
- GoDaddy – domain registration only; does not process personal data
- Revolut – processes payments made via payment links; we do not receive or store your card details

MongoDB Atlas stores our database in Ireland, within the EEA. Emergent, who host and run the application itself, process data in the United States – outside the UK and EEA.

Where we transfer personal data outside the UK and EEA, UK data protection law requires appropriate safeguards to be in place. Emergent has confirmed that no formal data transfer safeguard (such as Standard Contractual Clauses or a Data Processing Agreement) is currently available on our plan, or on any of their plans. We are aware of this gap and are actively considering our options, including with our hosting provider directly. If you have questions or concerns about this, please contact us using the details in Section 1.

6. How long we keep data

- Website enquiry data: kept while we're in contact about a potential trip, and for a reasonable period afterwards
- App and trip data: kept for the duration of the trip, and for as long as active testing continues. Fore Tour doesn't have a fixed end date for testing; when it does end, we will either continue keeping trip data as part of the ongoing service or delete it, and will update this policy to confirm which before that happens.

As noted elsewhere in the app, deleting a trip or round does not refund any usage allowance already used – but deletion does remove the associated data from active use.

7. Your rights

Under UK data protection law, you have the right to:

- Access the personal data we hold about you
- Have inaccurate data corrected
- Ask us to delete your data
- Object to or restrict certain uses of your data
- Receive your data in a portable format

8. Cookies

foretour.co.uk does not currently use non-essential tracking or advertising cookies.

9. Security

We take reasonable steps to protect the data we hold, but no method of storage or transmission over the internet is completely secure. Fore Tour is in active development and testing, and security measures continue to be reviewed and improved as the product matures.

10. Children

Fore Tour is designed to be used by adult organisers and players. Junior members of a golf society are welcome to take part in a trip, but their information is entered into the app by the trip organiser (or a parent/guardian), not created directly by the child themselves. Fore Tour does not offer self-service sign-up to anyone, junior or adult.

If you're an organiser adding a junior player's details (name and handicap index) to a trip, please make sure you have the appropriate permission from their parent or guardian to do so.

We do not knowingly collect personal data directly from children under 13. If we become aware that a child has provided us with personal data directly without appropriate parental or guardian consent, we will delete it, contact us using the details in Section 1 if you believe this has happened.

We may update this policy as Fore Tour develops. The "last updated" date at the top will always reflect the current version.
